President of BHA: Dave Friday of Newfane Circle has been nominated to fill this position. If there are any other nominations, please let us know. We will be voting on this at a follow up meeting on Sunday March 21st at 2:00.

Treasurer of BHA: We need someone to step up and take over this position from Nolen Campbell. It involves balancing the BHA checkbook, paying a few monthly bills and making deposits.

-Block Captains: We all agreed having block captains who help out with a small number of homes are again needed. The block captain would deliver flyers and reminders, deliver neighborhood info to new residents, distribute safety information and basically just be a source of information for residents in close proximity. We have a few people who have agreed to help out in this area, but we need more.

Yard of the Month Committee: This was a good way to encourage people to take care of their yards, but the signs were stolen and the whole thing fizzled out. We will be purchasing new signs and starting this up again.

Restrictions Enforcement Committee: We would like to have a small group who would write letters to residents who are violating neighborhood restrictions, kindly reminding them of our restrictions and advising them to comply.

Curb Clean-Up Committee: Twice a year (in Spring and Fall) remind residents to get out and clean up their yards and curbs.

Volunteer Pool: A group of residents who would be occasionally be willing to help out the elderly, sick or injured with general yard maintenance. We would also like to work on the creek at entrance one with this group.
